### **READINGS**

Psalm 95: v 1 – 7 Let Us Sing Songs of Praise

**95** Oh come, let us sing to the LORD;

let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

- <sup>2</sup> Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
- <sup>3</sup> For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
- <sup>4</sup> In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also.
- <sup>5</sup> The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.
- <sup>6</sup> Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!
- <sup>7</sup> For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

#### Matthew Ch. 25: v 31 - end

The Final Judgement

- <sup>31</sup> "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne.
- <sup>32</sup> Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.
- And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left.
   Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed
- by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. <sup>35</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, <sup>36</sup> I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you

came to me.' <sup>37</sup> Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? <sup>38</sup> And when did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? <sup>39</sup> And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?' <sup>40</sup> And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.' <sup>41</sup> "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

<sup>42</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, <sup>43</sup> I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.'

<sup>44</sup> Then they also will answer, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to you?' <sup>45</sup> Then he will answer them, saying, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.' <sup>46</sup> And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."
